Dancers arrive 45 minutes prior to their audition time for costume measurements & check – in. Casting is based on technique, maturity, musicality, and acting. **GROUP DANCE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS FROM AGE 3 TO ADULTS** such as *Christmas Lights, Soldiers, Mice, Reindeers, Snowflakes, Frosted Angels, Peppermint Drops, Candy Canes, Senioritas, Arabian Attendant, Lambs, Gingerbread Cookies, and Flowers* are cast without an audition during Ferla Ballet classes.

- 9:00 -10:00 Ladies ages 7-9 for Party Girls, Naughty Cookie, Lead Lamb, Lead Soldier, Star Lights
- 10:00 -11:30 Ladies ages 10 – 12 for Clara, Party Girls, Lead Lamb, Snow Fairy, Chinese Tea Lead, Marzipan Shepherdess, Ballerina Doll, Harlequin, Russian Ribbons, Spanish Cocoas, Chinese Tea (Beginning/Inter Pointe dancers may be called back to attend 11:30-12:30pm and 3:30-5:00pm)
- 12:30 -1:00 Boys ages 7 to 13 for Nutcracker, Fritz, Party Boys, Lead Soldier
- 1:00 -2:30 Acting Call Back for students who attended the 10:00 audition for the role of Clara.
- 3:30 -5:00 Intermediate / Advanced Pointe
- Women and men ages 13+ for Sugar Plum Fairy, Cavalier, Snow Queen, Arabian Coffee, Snow Fairy, Rose, Spanish Cocoa Lead, Chinese Tea Lead, Marzipan Shepherdess, Ballerina Doll, Harlequin, Russian Ribbons, Spanish Cocoas
- 5:00 -5:30 Pas de deux call back for students who attended the 3:30 audition. Sugar Plum Fairy, Cavalier, Snow Pas & Arabian
- 5:30 -6:15 Teen/Adult female and male actors for Drosselmeyer, Party Scene Mothers and Fathers, Maid, Mouse King, Mother Cupcake

What to Bring:

- 2" x 3" photo which will not be returned
- \$365 soloist performance fee per student covers the audition, group roles, 20-45 rehearsal and performance hours outside of class time, 2-6 costume rentals, theater costs, t-shirt, "Kiss the Cast" candies, and DVD. In the event that a student is not cast as a soloist, the \$100 difference will be credited toward the student's SJYB Nutcracker account. \$10 off each additional sibling. No performance fee for boys and adult actors. Donations are welcome. Scholarships are available.
- Snacks and water in case you are called back to audition longer.
- Ladies: hair up away from the face in a secure bun (no ponytails); color leotard colors, pink tights, pink ballet shoes / Boys: Tight fitting white t-shirt, black tights, and Bloch S0205 black ballet shoes.

Participation Requirements:

- Parents with dancers ages 7 – 18 volunteer a minimum of 16 hours or \$280 volunteer buy-out. Parents with dancers ages 3-6 volunteer a minimum of 10 hours or buy – out \$140 volunteer buy out.
- Minimum of 10 performance tickets per student.
- Attendance for studio run – through on Dec 1, Dec 2, Dec 3.
- Attendance for theater staging rehearsals Dec 4 to Dec 8.
- 2-5 performances depending on the dancer's role/s held on Dec 8, Dec 9, Dec 10.
- Soloist and demi-soloist roles rehearse on either Fridays, Saturdays, and/or Sundays beginning September 23rd. Group roles rehearse during DTI's Ferla Ballet School classes.
- Group performance fee per student covers 15-35 rehearsal and performance hours outside of class time, 1-5 costume rentals, theater costs, t-shirt, and "Kiss the Cast" candies. Ages 7 and older \$265; Ages 3-6 \$165.
